STAKES Belmont Sprint Championship S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$400 each which should accompany the nomination; \$2,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$2,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$6,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The guaranteed purse to be divided accordingly, \$220,000 to the owner of the winner, \$80,000 to second, \$48,000 to third, \$24,000 to fourth, \$12,000 to fifth, \$8,000 to sixth with the remaining \$8,000 to be divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 119 lbs. Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade One in 2015-16 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Grade Two in 2015-16 allowed, 4 lbs.; of a Grade Three race in 2015-16 allowed 6 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred allowance races in 2016 allowed 8 lbs.; of such a race since then, 10 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 25, 2016 with 14 Nominations.

Footnotes

A. P. INDIAN broke inwards brushing the near side stall before taking over the lane of ROXBURY N OVERTON, pinching that foe back in tandem with NUBIN RIDGE, tracked the pace three wide early on down the backstretch as rivals in front raced out five to six paths off the inside, tucked to the two path into the turn with nine-sixteenths to go, came under urging three furlongs out, advanced through the latter portion of the turn to issue a challenge spinning two to three wide for home, took over command straightened away, inched away under a drive to the eighth pole confronted by the eventual runner up, dug in and was guided out by the rider through a near sided rein in the final eighth while under an off sided stick to control the move to look his main danger in the eye a sixteenth from home, dug in gamely and held on to prevail repelling the challenge at the wire. MARKING raced marooned seven to eight wide in aim of the front down the backstretch due to PRIVATE ZONE getting out headstrong under a tight and firm grip by his rider in the six path to the inside, tucked to be four to five wide into the turn as that rival took to the three path, came under coaxing midway on the bend, cornered five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive offering up a good kick to latch on the aforementioned foe through the final sixteenth but was ultimately rebuffed at the finish while clear of the rest for the place honors. READY FOR RYE four wide in pursuit, came under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, swung six wide into upper stretch under a drive, offered up a mild bid to the eighth pole, couldn't sustain the momentum and flattened out in the final sixteenth while along for the show honors. PRIVATE ZONE established the front and grew headstrong fighting the rating of the rider requiring a firm hold as the pair drifted out to the six path down the backstretch floating GREEN GRATTO to the seven path and MARKING to the eight path, tossed his head stargazing before darting to tuck three wide into the bend with nine-sixteenths to go, remained under a strong hold appearing to be wanting to get out and continuing to pull on the bit before put to coaxing by the rider three furlongs from home, floated four wide into upper stretch under flanking challenges and capitulated straightened away for home, then weakened in the late stages having spent quite a bit of energy fighting his rider in the early going. GREEN GRATTO hustled from the gate,

raced seven wide down the backstretch early on more out of necessity than strategy as the aforementioned foe grew headstrong getting out to the six path to his inside, tucked four wide with nine-sixteenths to go following the tuck by that same rival, came under coaxing midway on the turn, swung four wide at the quarter pole and weakened in the final furlong. NUBIN RIDGE broke out a step at the start pinching back ROXBURY N OVERTON in tandem with A.P. INDIAN who broke inwards, raced three wide in pursuit, came under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, angled seven wide into upper stretch, made no impact. ROXBURY N OVERTON pinched at the start as A.P. INDIAN broke inwards and NUBIN RIDGE came out slightly, tucked to be two to three wide early on before taking briefly to the four path approaching the turn, tucked inside into the turn coming under a ride midway, angled three wide into upper stretch and tired.
