DHARMASTER was bumped at the break, quickly recovered and moved up three wide the first turn, dropped in a bit leaving the three quarter pole to prompt the pace of CLUBMAN, moved alongside that one leaving the far turn, dueled between rivals into the lane, had ROYAL HUSSAR gain a short lead to his outside leaving the three sixteenths, battled back under left handed encouragement and went clear at the wire. ROYAL HUSSAR stalked the pace three wide, edged closer when called upon departing the far turn, battled three deep into the lane, moved to command past the three sixteenths, dueled, switched to his left lead and was out finished. CLUBMAN cleared early, set the pace towards the rail, was joined around the far turn, dueled inside the top pair from the five sixteenths to mid stretch and gave way grudgingly. CANNAVARO bumped with the winner at the break, stalked the pace in two path, came under a hustling ride with three furlongs remaining and came up empty. NO REGRETS settled outside of a rival early on, gained three wide under a ride past the five sixteenths, shifted out a bit further entering the lane, chased to mid stretch then flattened out late. CRUZIN WITH PACHI was angled in early and failed to menace. MAJOR METRO was steadied along early while toward the inside, relaxed better nearing the half, failed to kick on leaving the far turn and weakened.
