Footnotes

READY FOR RYE coaxed from the gate, prompted the pace from the four path, followed the leader inside nearing the five-sixteenths, took over command at that station, got set down spinning just off the inside for home, inched away under a drive closely pursued by a trio and held sway to the finish. LIFE IN SHAMBLES three wide in pursuit, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing midway on the turn, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid. ALL STAR RED chased four then three wide coming under encouragement five-sixteenths out, spun three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. THREEFIVEINDIA chased three then two wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, cut the corner into upper stretch, fought on inside through to the finish but was outfinished late on. STREET BABE chased five wide under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, swung six wide into upper stretch and improved position by mostly tired foes. CANDID DESIRE five to six wide early on, tucked to the three path half a mile from home, came under a ride midway on the turn, swung five wide into upper stretch and offered no response. ALEX THE TERROR three to four wide in pursuit from just off the pace, got coaxed along at the three-eighths, cornered four wide at the quarter pole, tired. HEY JABBER JAW hustled from the gate, established the front and showed the way from the three path under pressure from READY FOR RYE to the outside, got headed five-sixteenths from home, swung three wide into upper stretch shaken off and faltered in the stretch.
