Footnotes

DJULPAN three wide in closest aim of the leader, remained patiently handled until set down continuing three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, dug in under late challenge and held safe to prevail. SON OF OAHU saved ground in mid pack early on before advancing to be just

off the pace into the far turn, got let out spinning three wide into upper stretch, closed well to threaten late but was rebuffed to the wire. MANIFEST DESTINY rated on the pace just off the inside through sensible splits, awaited a challenge in hand through to nearing the quarter pole when the eventual winner ranged up outside, spun just off the inside for home roused for the stretch drive, dug in and was headed a furlong out, ran on through to the finish to secure the show honors. UNBROKEN CHAIN tracked the pace from the two path coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, swung three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. THERE GOES BEN just off the inside near the rear, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly but could not impact the top four. TWO DOWN ONE TO GO three wide through the opening dog legged turn, raced three to four wide from just off the pace, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung four wide for home and weakened in the late stages. OPEN BAR just off the inside near the rear, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under a ride at the three-eighths, continued just off the inside into upper stretch and passed tired foes in the drive. CROCE D'ORO three then two wide in pursuit from mid pack, got coaxed along midway on the far turn, went seven wide into upper stretch, weakened. SUTTER'S MILL three wide through the opening dog legged bend, settled four to five wide near the rear, came under coaxing midway on the far turn, swung three to four wide for home and made no impact. MR GREY (FR) two to three wide in mid pack, came under coaxing three furlongs out, swung four wide for home and offered no response. FULMER three to four wide at the tail of the field, got coaxed along three furlongs out, swung six wide into upper stretch and made no impact. ISOFASS just off the pace four to five wide, got coaxed along at the three-eighths, angled eight wide into upper stretch and tired.
