BASIC HERO away a half length fastest of all, got engaged by SHOOT THE GAP seemingly from the get-go, sat entrenched in the two path staving that foe off all the way to the quarter pole, shifted into the three path at the top of the lane and was given its cue, kicked clear, kept busy to the end. SHOOT THE GAP got hooked up with the winner after springing from the gate without apparent mishap, prompted that opponent to its outside, got put to a drive for the drive, proved no match, yet held well for the place, even while drifting out down the stretch. WON'T BURN put to hand encouragement after leaving the gate, pursued the top twosome from the four path on the turn, was already under a drive before reaching the end of the bend, moved outward until seven wide late, ultimately having to settle for the show after being outfinished. SPRING EMPEROR rode the rail on the turn, cut the corner having been put to a drive before doing so, lacked the needed response. MIKADO hit the left side of the starting gate, failed to make its presence off the ground-saving journey that followed. DUBLIN EXPRESS hung out three to four wide on the turn, was no factor. STORM SCAT three wide entering the turn, offered no response when asked to pick it up past the midway point. BENEFICIAL RISK in the two path and between rivals for the opening half, folded.
