YUMMY BEAR settled into the two path after an apparent clean getaway, rated well, patiently chasing the leader for the opening three-quarters and a tad more, was put to a drive tipping to the outside at the end of the far turn, eventually taking the three path for entrance into the stretch, straightened away and took off in earnest after the ones to catch, steadily chopped away at the deficit, proving best by getting up in the final seventy yards. MANIFEST DESTINY quickly established control and glided over to the rail, carved out the pace taking the inside route, with E J'S LEGACY in accompaniment out in the two path, continued along under the same scenario all the way to the quarter pole, got asked for more as the previously-mentioned foe launched his best bid, turned back a stiff challenge during the ensuing furlong, gained no respite and instead came under attack by the top one, relinquished with some reluctance with well under a sixteenth remaining. STORM PROPHET brushed into the side of the starting being released by the starter and almost right afterwards with PECULIAR SENSATION, remained along the rail and rode it for nearly three-quarters, was on the move to the outside for the commencement of the stretch run, worked his way into the four path by midlane, rallied with some energy securing the show. ODE TO THE HUNT dove over to the inside soon after the start, inched his way onto the left border of the two path travelling along the backstretch, was more firmly in path two for the run around the second bend, swung four wide into the stretch, was forced to idle along behind a host of opponents from upper stretch to the vicinity of the sixteenth marker, maintaining interest under light urging from the pilot throughout the entire ordeal, finally found racing room along the three path and accelerated his way into it, split rivals after a few additional strides and flashed strong, but belated energy. E J'S LEGACY prompted the pacesetter from the two path, was given his cue and mustered up a strong bid from the head of the stretch to midlane, couldn't go by and weakened. SHIRAZ was gently pinched after scraping the side of the gate, kept watch on the front runners from the two path, was set down spinning into the stretch and failed to fire. THE GREAT SAMURAI five deep along the rail early, was never involved. PECULIAR SENSATION brushed with STORM PROPHET after making some contact with gate, tracked the front runners while saving ground, got put to a drive for the drive and lacked the needed response. NUTZFORBOLTZ leapt into the gate, landing hard on the course afterwards, raced in the two path for three-quarters, tipped out into the third one at the five-sixteenths pole, made into the stretch and had no offering.
