MANIFEST DESTINY established the front from the get go and showed the way in hand along the inside through the opening bend before taking to the two path down the backstretch, settled into a comfortable rhythm through moderate splits under watch from UNCLE CHESTER to the outside, remained patiently handled awaiting a challenge and got one for the initial time five-sixteenths from home getting put to urging in response, cut the corner into upper stretch, dug in under challenge from MISSION LEADER to the outside and held gamely to rebuff that foe to the finish kept busy to the wire. MISSION LEADER crossed inside shortly after the start and caused a bit of a traffic jam as STORM PROPHET followed suit as his lane tightened past the finish line for the first time, settled tracking just off the inside in range of the leader, tucked inside three furlongs from home, came under coaxing five-sixteenths out, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, rallied to latch on the aforementioned foe through the final eighth, dug in but was ultimately repelled to the finish while securing the place honors. STORM PROPHET got squeezed in a bit tight by the aforementioned foe after shifting inwards shortly after the start and placed rivals in behind off heels forcing them to steady due to the pressure from MISSION LEADER to the outside, settled just off the pace three wide in pursuit in hand until put to encouragement five-sixteenths from home, angled out six wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick for the show honors. ODE TO THE HUNT pinched at the start due to pressure from UNCLE CHESTER coming inwards, steadied very briefly before remaining unhurried three to four wide near the rear of the field, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, angled out eight wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly for the last major share. JUPITER RISING three to four wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing tucked just off the inside at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into upper stretch in behind the leader, ran on through the stretch but was outfinished in the late stages. LEAD BY EXAMPLE two to three wide at the

tail of the field, tucked inside with nine-sixteenths to run, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, swung six wide at the quarter pole, closed well through the stretch by tired rivals and was unable to impact the top quintet to the wire. BLAME THE THIEF got bumped and squeezed between foes and forced to steady off the heels of rivals the first time past the wire as MISSION LEADER and STORM PROPHET crossed inside tightening up the lanes, was hard held off the heels of NUTZFORBOLTZ and JO'S BOLD CAT into the first turn before able to settle saving ground near the rear, came under coaxing three furlongs out, swung four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid but was outkicked. NUTZFORBOLTZ brushed the off side stall at the start, then was steadied and bumped when off the heels of STORM PROPHET with one mile to go, settled four to five wide in pursuit from mid pack down the backstretch after being just off the inside through the first turn, tucked three to four wide into the far turn coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung seven wide into upper stretch, kept on through the drive but was outkicked in the late going. CODY'S NOTES bumped solidly off stride with one mile remaining due to the tightening of lanes as rivals crossed over in front of others, saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, came under a drive five-sixteenths from home, cut the corner into upper stretch and made no impact. UNCLE CHESTER forwardly placed two to three wide, came under encouragement five-sixteenths out, swung three to four wide at the head of the stretch and weakened in the late stages. JO'S BOLD CAT got bumped between foes and squeezed a sixteenth after the start before growing rank hard held off the heels of CODY'S NOTES into the first turn, settled just off the inside near the rear, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung two to three wide for home and offered no response.
